The CESI Graduate School of Engineering, which includes the ei.CESI and exia.CESI programs, is a multicenter degree program that covers the whole national territory. Each year, the graduate school welcomes more than 5000 pupils, two-third of whom are in combined work-study schemes. Over 21 000 engineers have graduated from the CESI Graduate School of Engineering since its creation.
